

DIGITAL PROJECTED IMAGES:

These should be resized so that they are a maximum of 1600 pixels wide or 1200 pixels tall and with a file size of less than 2Megapixels. You do not need to fill in the empty space around your images - a portrait image would be 1200 pixels tall and maybe only 1000 pixels wide. Similarly, a landscape image may not necessarily use the full allowed height.

Image files are always required to be saved in JPEG format using sRGB colour space, with a file type of '.jpg'. When saving a JPEG file, the user will be offered a quality setting option either as a number (maximum 12), or a percentage, this should be adjusted to obtain the correct file size.

An option worth considering before resizing an image is whether to add a Border/Stroke to the image. For competitions the image will be projected against a black background, and for some images (e.g. a black background) it may be difficult to tell where the boundaries of the image are meant to be.
